Student Dress Code 2023

The P&C Association of Windsor State School endorses a student dress code policy because they believe it:

- Promotes a safe environment for learning by enabling ready identification of students and non-students at the school,
- Promotes an effective teaching and learning environment by eliminating the distraction of competition in dress and fashion at the school,
- Promotes a supportive environment at the school by fostering a sense of culture and belonging,
- Fosters mutual respect among individuals at the school by minimising visible evidence of economic, class or social differences, and
- Creates a good image of the school within the community and encourages students to uphold and enhance that image.

The P&C Association have designed our uniform to consist of the following:

School Uniform (Sports)

Polo Shirt / House Polo Shirt*
Royal Blue Shorts/Culottes
Slouch Hat or Bucket Hat
Swimming Cap / Togs / Sun Shirt**
White Socks
Black shoes
Sporting events only: running shoes, bike pants (optional)

School Uniform (Formal) ***

Check Shirt/Check Dress
Formal Royal Blue Shorts/Culottes
Slouch Hat or Bucket Hat
White Socks
Black Shoes

School Uniform (Music)

Music Polo Shirt
Formal Royal Blue Shorts/Culottes
White Socks
Black Shoes

* House polo shirts are strongly encouraged to be worn on a Thursday during Pastoral Care lessons.

Sun shirts and swimming caps **must be worn for all swimming lessons.

*** The formal school uniform is strongly encouraged to be worn by all students on a Monday.

All students are expected to wear the full school uniform daily. Students must wear the school's formal uniform (not sports uniform) when leaving the school on an excursion. School hats must be worn at all times outside of the classroom.

Cooler Weather

Royal blue jumper
Royal blue tracksuit pants can be worn in place of the school shorts/culottes
Navy or black plain leggings/tights can be worn under school dresses/culottes.

Grooming

Students' hair must be neat and tidy and of natural hair colouring only. All hair that falls over the collar should be tied back to help minimise the spread of head lice. Hair accessories (e.g. hair bands, clips etc) are to be blue or white in colour.

Jewellery and Makeup

The only acceptable jewellery items are a watch, stud or sleeper earrings or a medical alert bracelet/necklace. Make-up is not a part of the school uniform and must not be worn. This includes eyelashes and fingernails that are of an appropriate length and are natural in colour.
