




Registration Process

HOW TO SET UP A QKR! ACCOUNT

1) Registration Home Page

Click on the following link to navigate to the [Qkr!](#) registration page on your mobile or PC




2) Sign-In Page

Existing families Use previous login details. If you can't retrieve your previous login details using the 'forgotten password' option, you will need to register as a new user.


3) Home page

Create Profile


- 4) Click on the Add Profile button to create a profile for registration.

HOW TO REGISTER FOR SEAWOLVES


- 1) Scroll down the menu and select Seawolves 2025-2026 registration




- 2) Select a profile to link the purchase to

External families who have previously used Qkr! Can use previous login details. If you can't retrieve your previous login details using the 'forgotten password' option, you will need to register as a new user.


- 3) Select your membership
